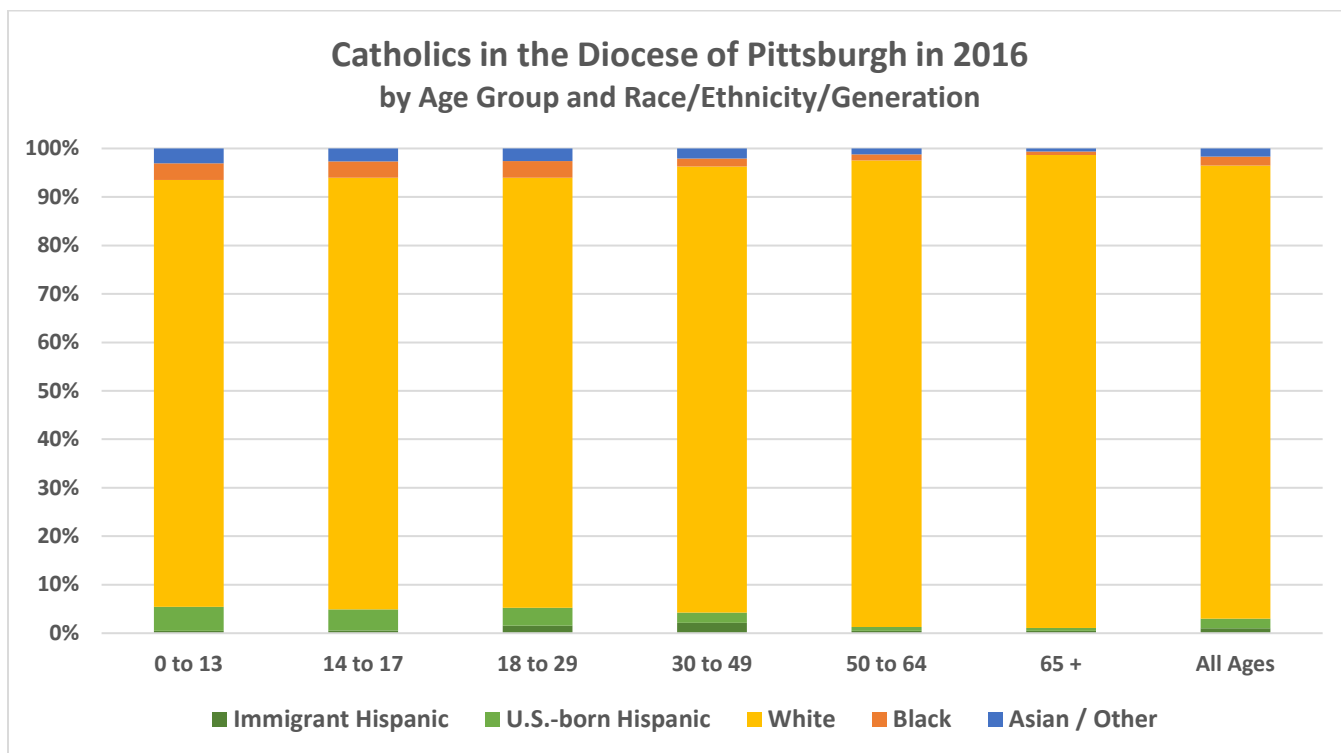

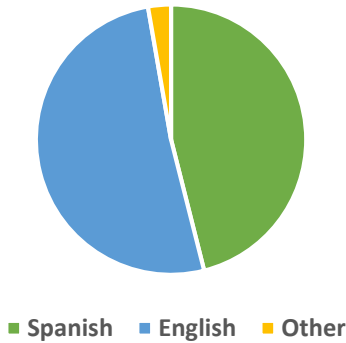

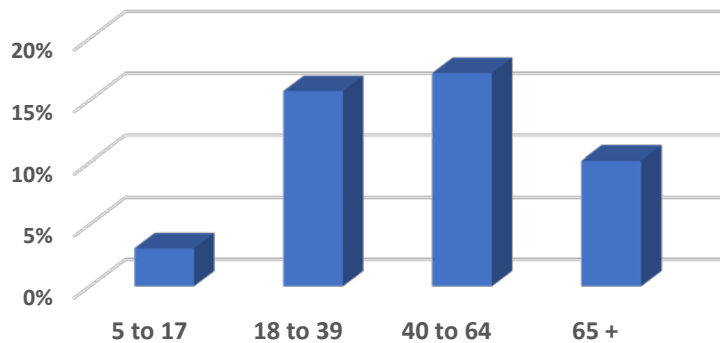

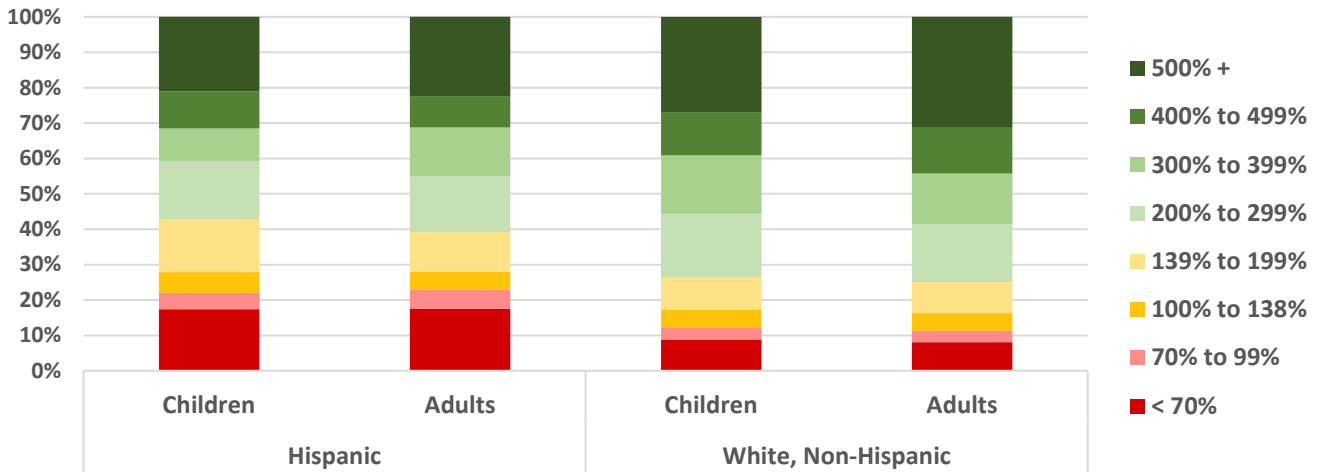
Hispanic/Latino Household Language, 2012 to 2015



Hispanics/Latinos Who Do Not Speak English "Very Well" from 2012 to 2015, by Age



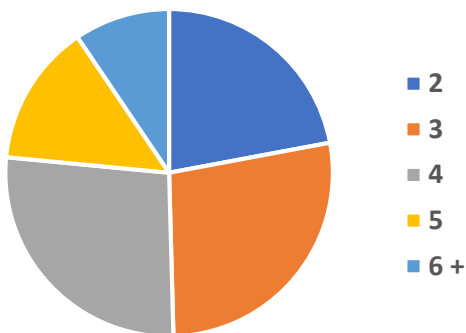
Household Income as a Percentage of Poverty Level, 2012 to 2015

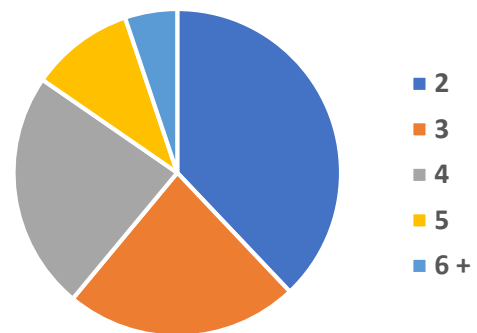

Hispanic Family Size, 2012 to 2015



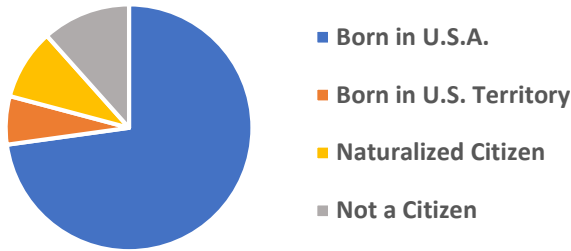

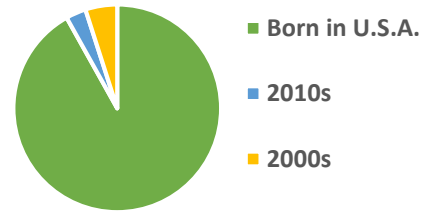

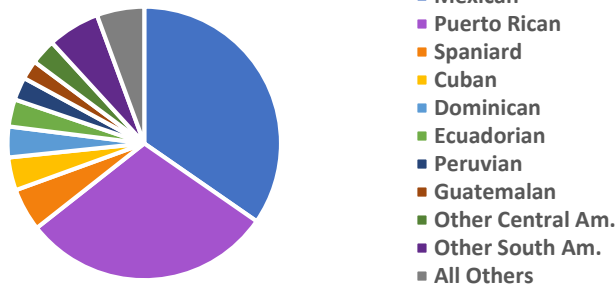
Citizenship of Hispanic Residents, 2012 to 2015



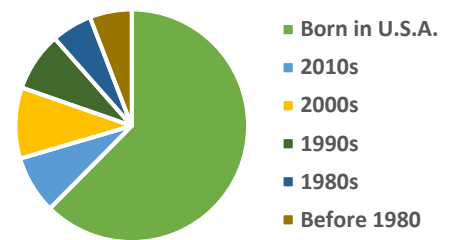
Decade of Entry for Hispanic Children



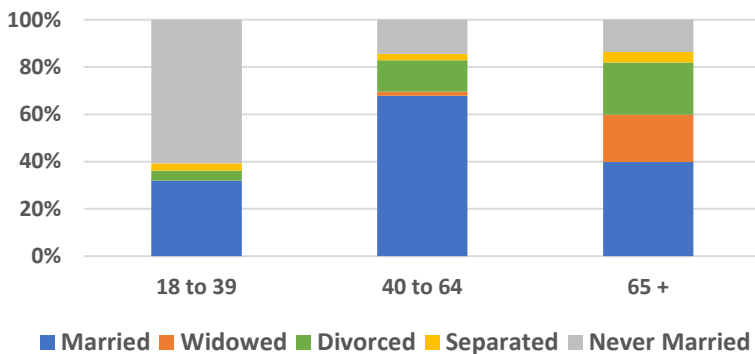
National Heritage of Hispanic Residents, 2012 to 2015



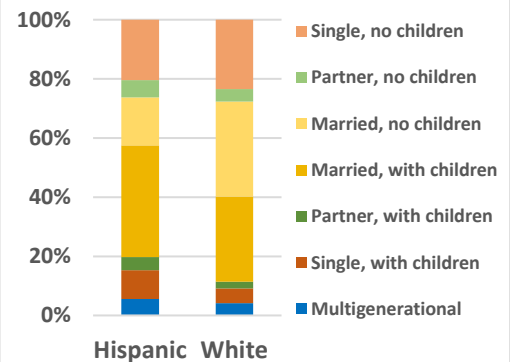
Decade of Entry for Hispanic Adults



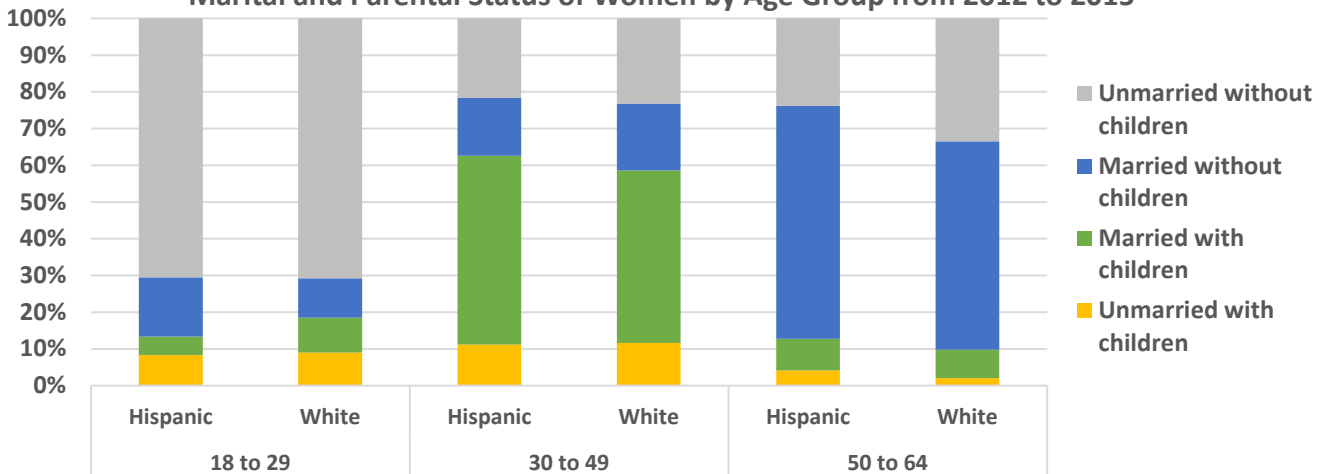
Hispanic Marital Status by Age from 2012 to 2015

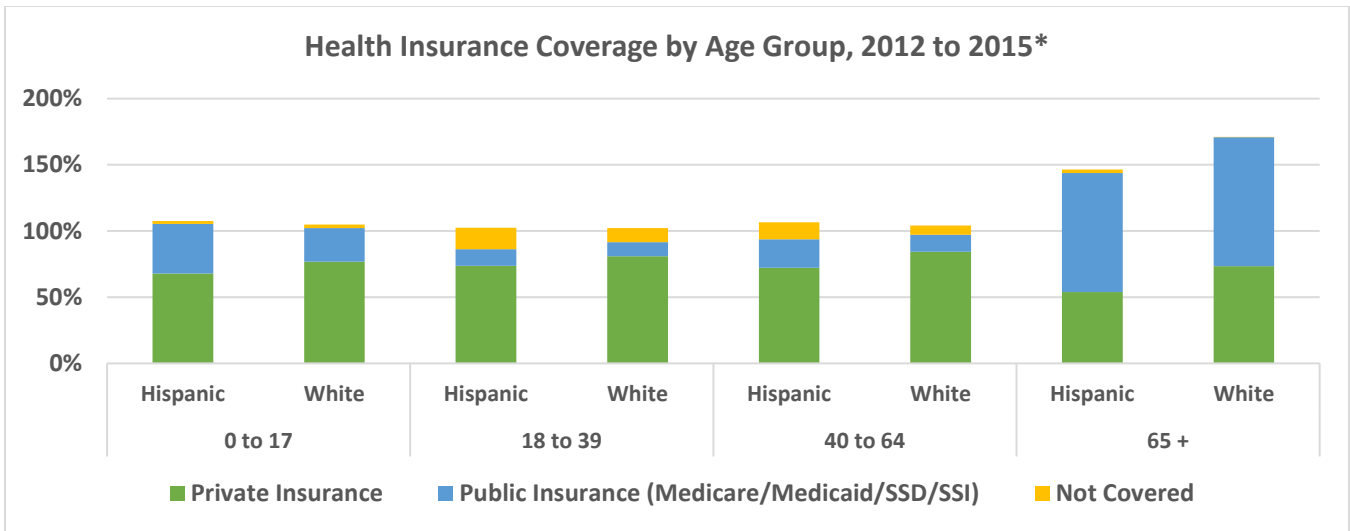


Household Type, 2012 to 2015
