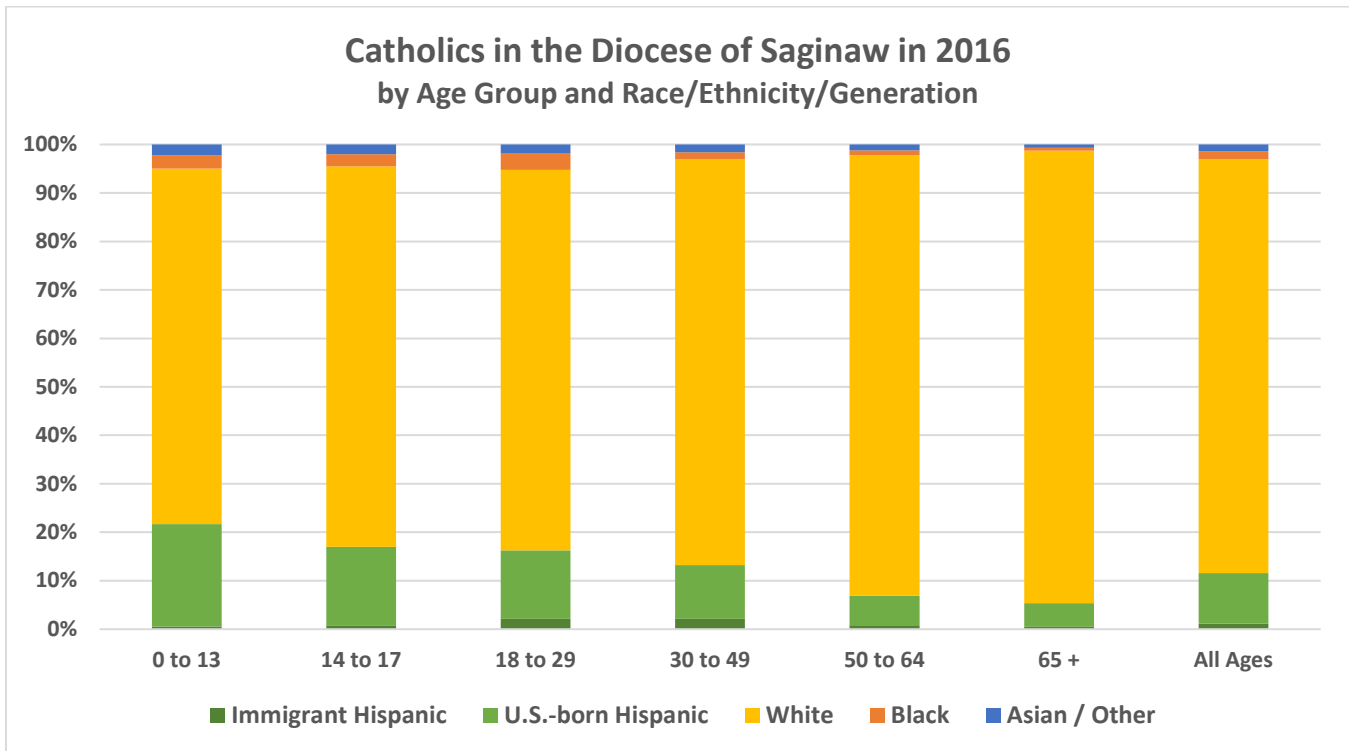

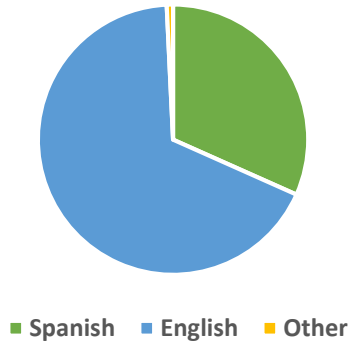

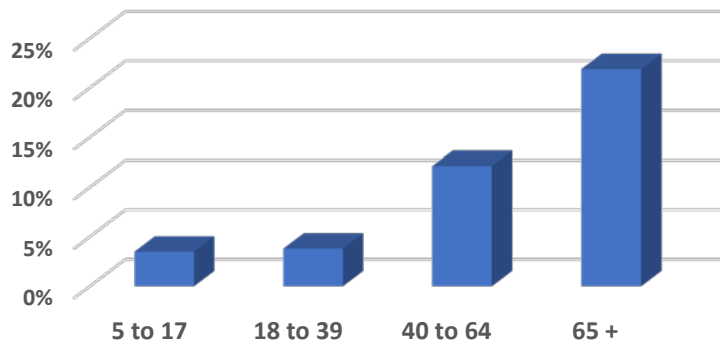

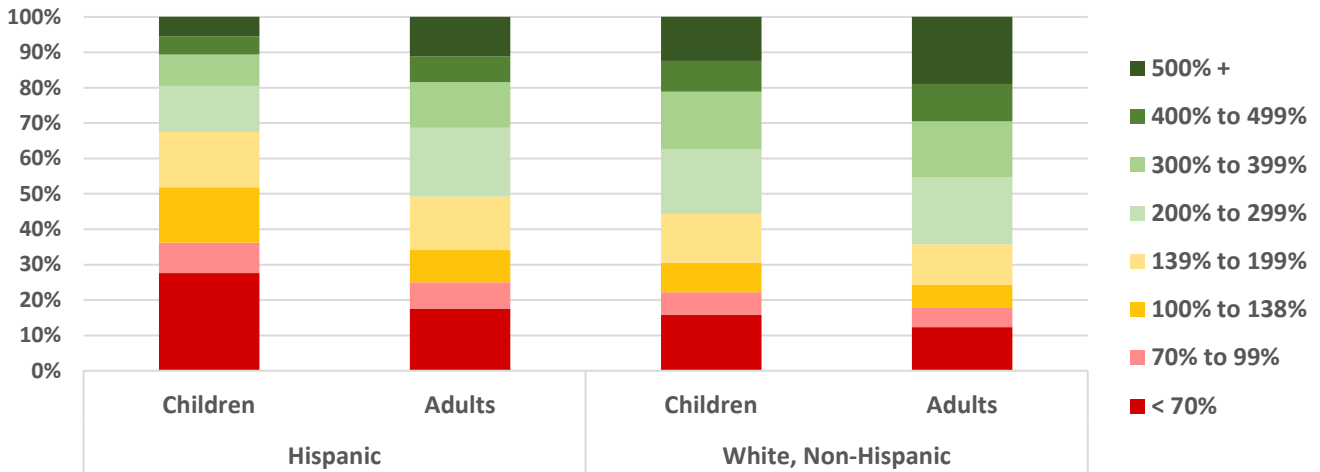
**Hispanic/Latino Household Language, 2012 to 2015**



**Hispanics/Latinos Who Do Not Speak English "Very Well" from 2012 to 2015, by Age**



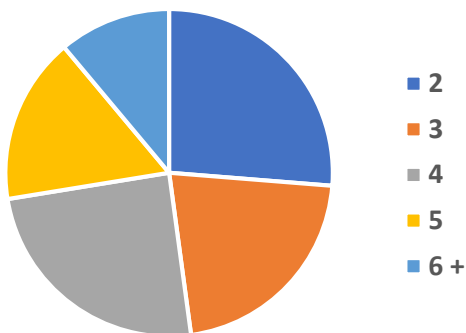
**Household Income as a Percentage of Poverty Level, 2012 to 2015**

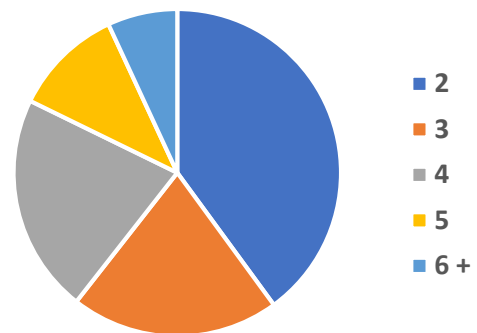

**Hispanic Family Size, 2012 to 2015**



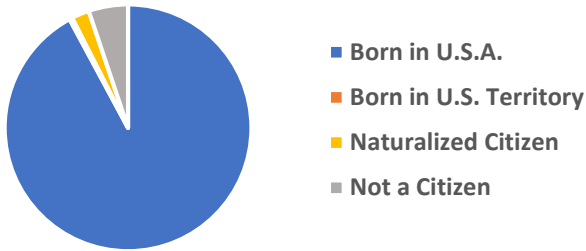

**White, Non-Hispanic Family Size**

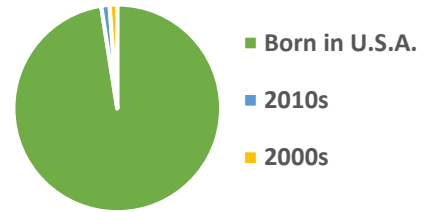

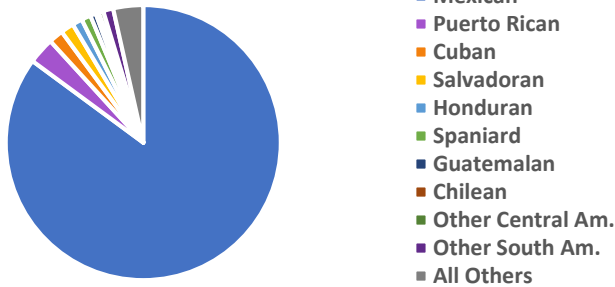
**Citizenship of Hispanic Residents, 2012 to 2015**



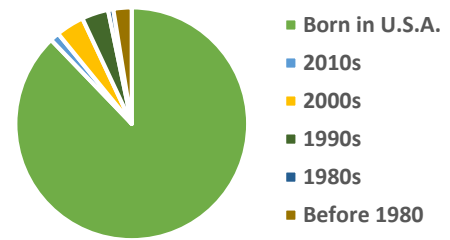
**Decade of Entry for Hispanic Children**



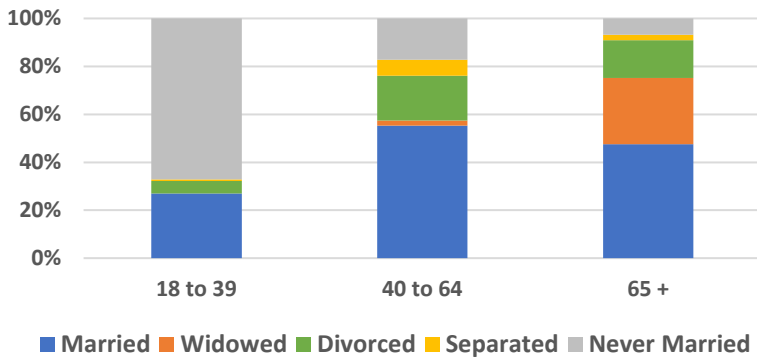
**National Heritage of Hispanic Residents, 2012 to 2015**



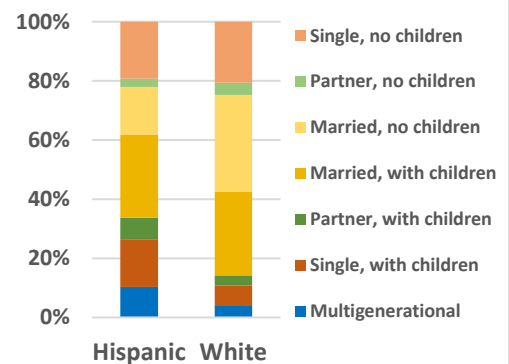
**Decade of Entry for Hispanic Adults**



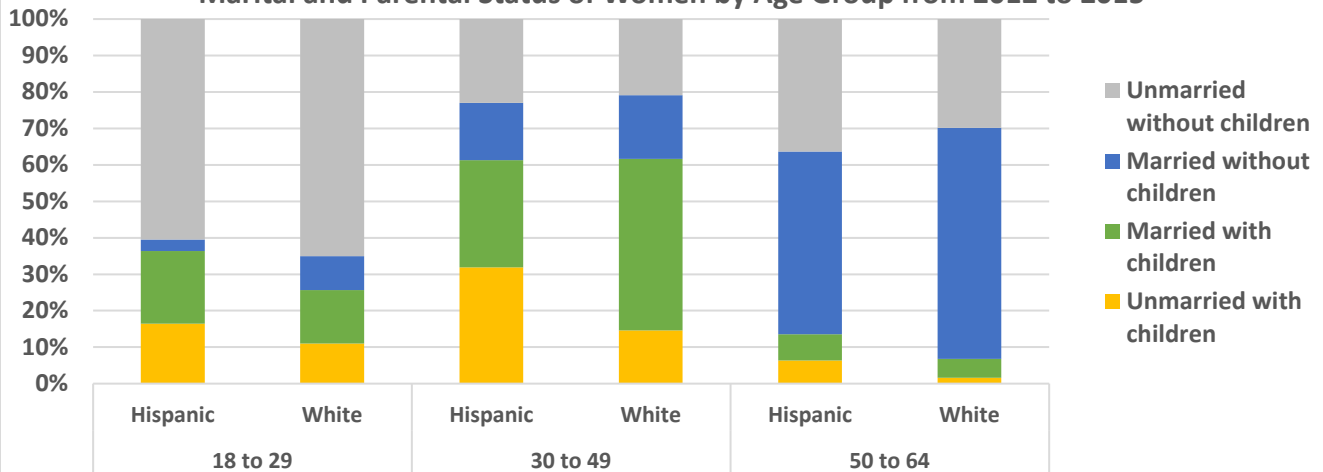
**Hispanic Marital Status by Age from 2012 to 2015**

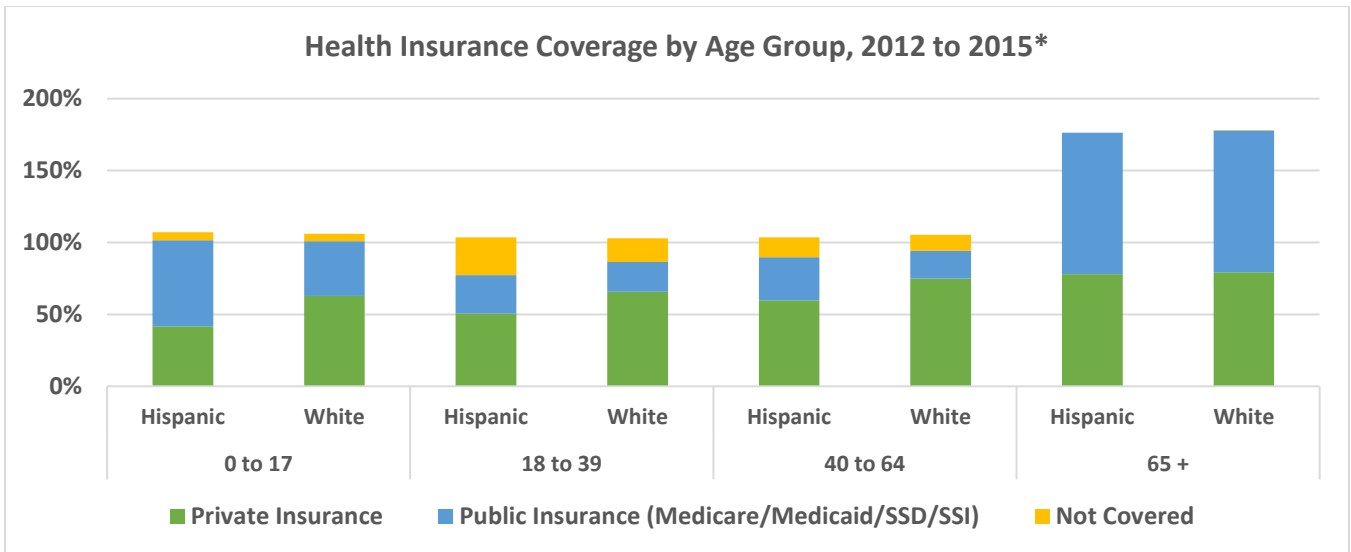


**Household Type, 2012 to 2015**
