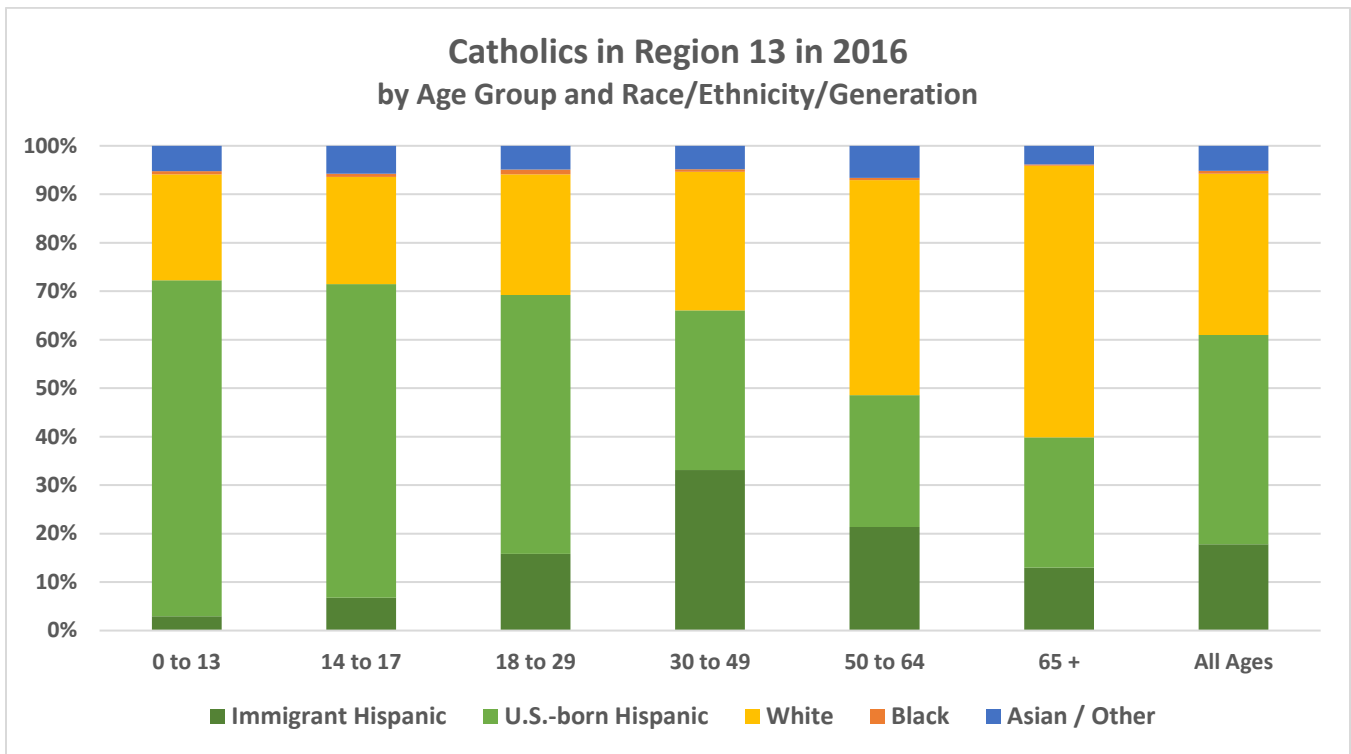

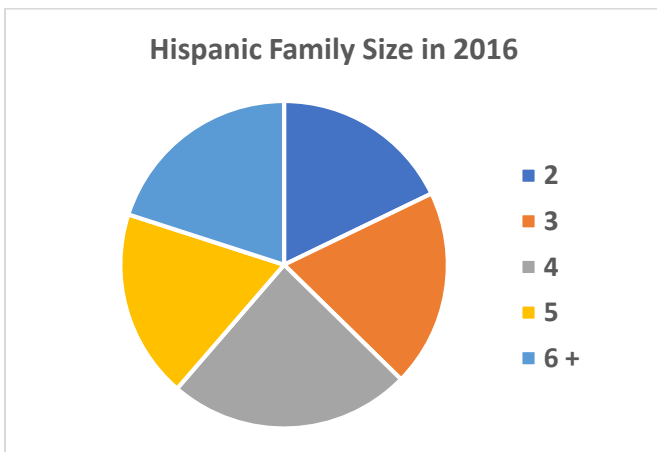

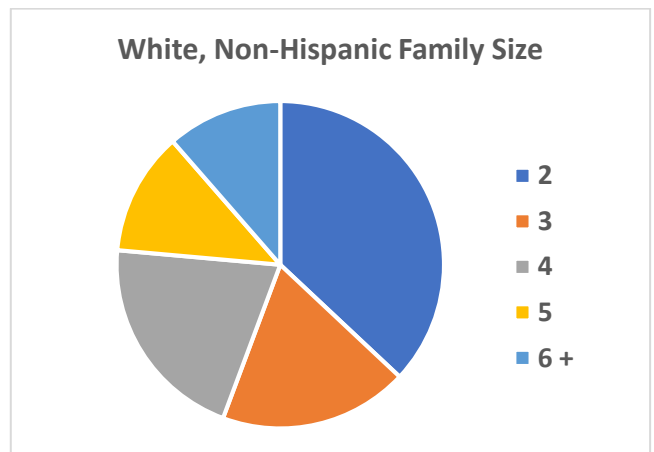


Median Hispanic Household Income: **\$51,500**

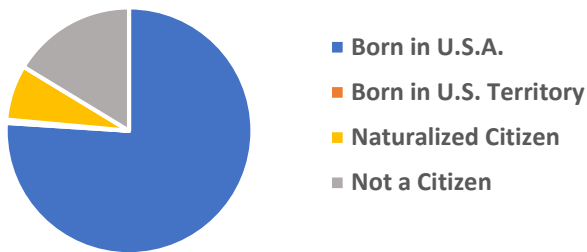

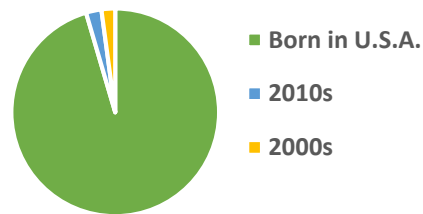

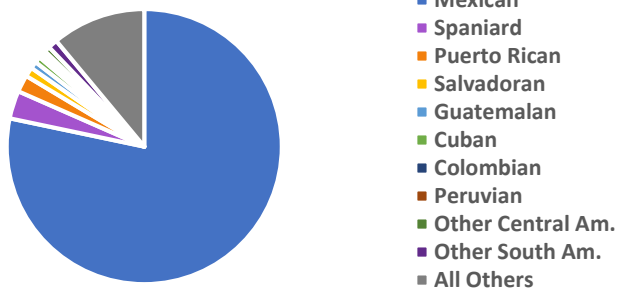
**Citizenship of Hispanic Residents in 2016**



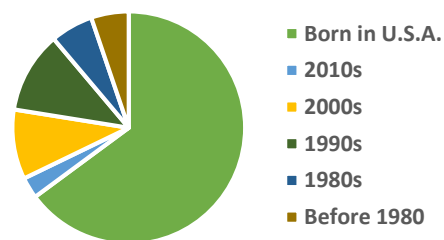
**Decade of Entry for Hispanic Children**



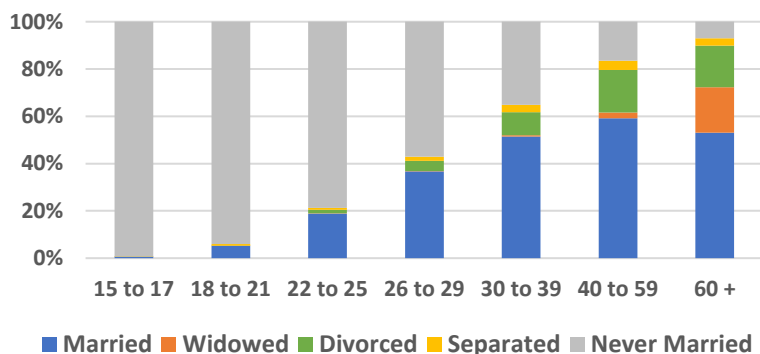
**National Heritage of Hispanic Residents in 2016**



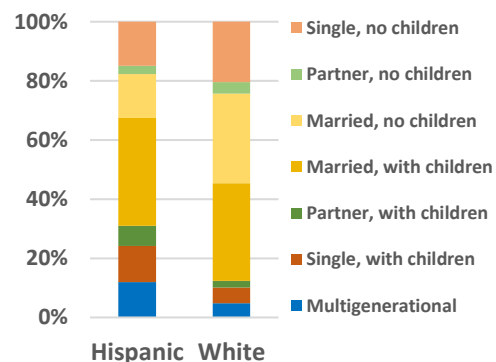
**Decade of Entry for Hispanic Adults**



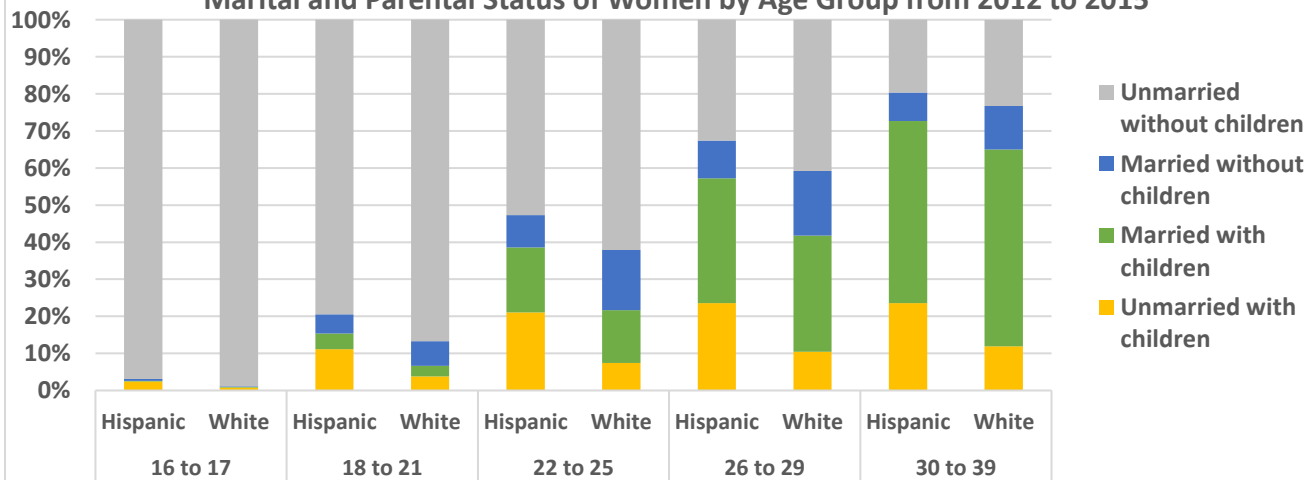
**Hispanic Marital Status by Age in 2016**



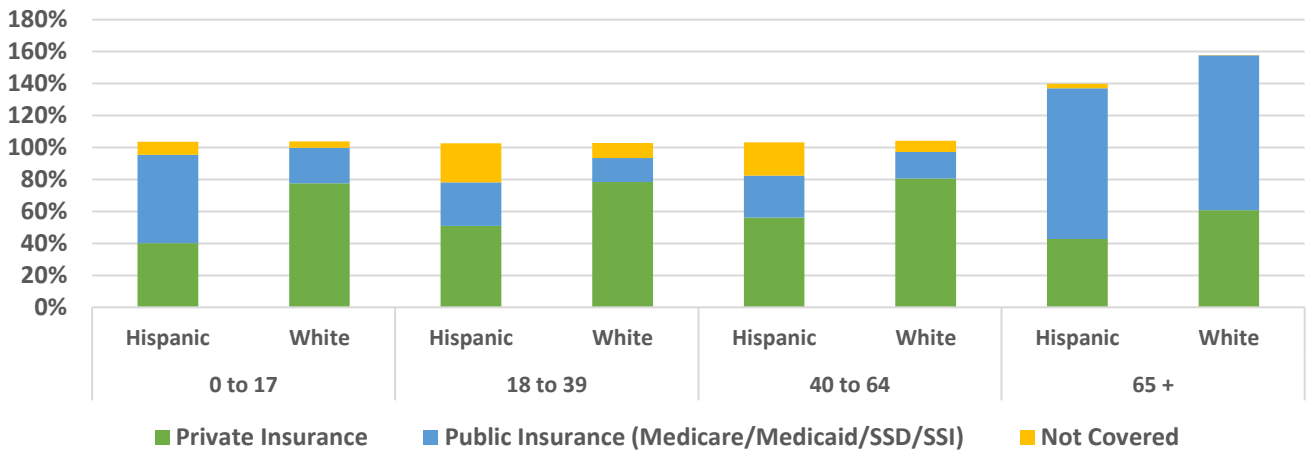
**Household Type, 2012 to 2015**



**Marital and Parental Status of Women by Age Group from 2012 to 2015**

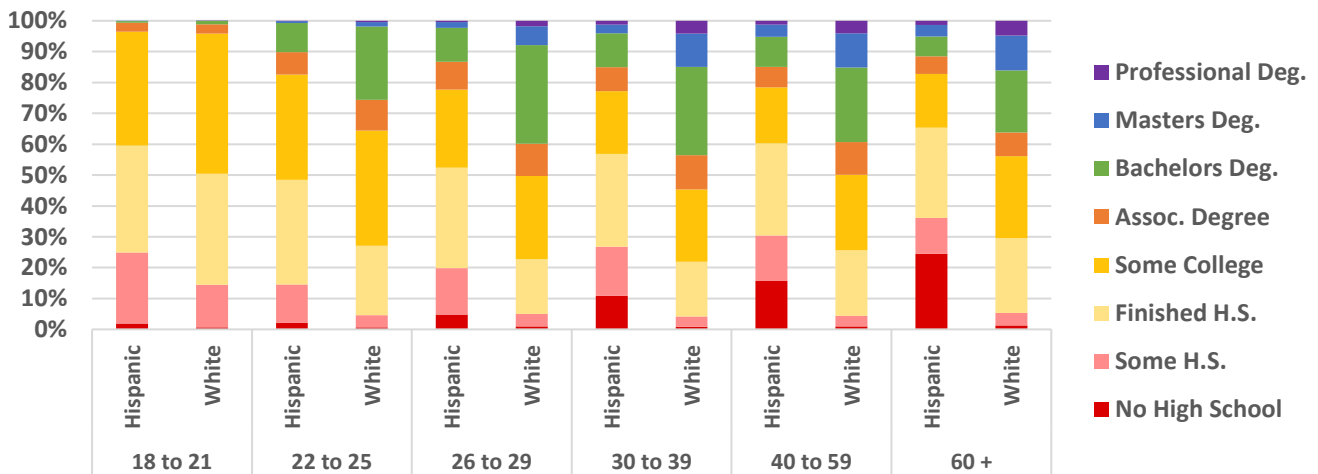


### Health Insurance Coverage by Age Group in 2016\*
